
There will be a period of ten minutes prior to the commencement of the meeting when members of the public can ask questions; your attendance is requested during this period.

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### AGENDA

3. **CHAIRMAN'S REPORT.**

5. **FINANCIAL REPORT.** To receive a Financial report of Full Council and Committee status.

12. **TO CONSIDER ASKING THE CLERK TO CONTACT NKDC AND LCC FOR INFORMATION.** - There have been instances in the media, recently where Officers of NKDC and LCC have made public their views relating to Sleaford issues which conflict with information available to the Town Council. One related to Network Rail and the associated Railway Bridge. Could the Clerk, on behalf of the Town Council, make representations to NKDC and LCC, with advice from LALC as required, to ensure that the proper democratic procedures of Councillors are not undermined.
