- 009 It was requested that the new Bank Mandate is set up without further delay.

A.7 CLERK/OFFICERS' REPORT ON MATTERS OUTSTANDING/ PROGRESS MADE.

- 7.1 **Planning Consultants** Staff Changes. These changes were noted.
- 7.2 **LCC Traffic Regulation Order** (2nd June 2015) Tamar Road & Church Lane (Prohibition of Waiting Amendment Order 20.) This item was noted
- 7.3 Tourism Signs & Directional Signs in and around Sleaford. Reply from LCC (18.06.15). Members expressed disappointment at the County Council's response and IT WAS RESOLVED to comment as such, also that Cllr M. Allan would contact L.C.C. (Mr Rowan Smith) in his capacity as a County Councillor. Of particular concern is directing traffic along Boston Road. Cllr M Allan will report back to this Committee. Vote 12 for and 1 abstention. The Resolution was carried.
- 7.4 **Tree Works, St. George's Academy** (from Planning Meeting 03.06.15). Reply from Arboricultural Technician. *IT WAS RESOLVED THAT* to reply, expressing STC's disappointment at the lack of intention to provide replacement trees. Vote Unanimous. The Resolution was carried.
- 7.5 **Temporary** Traffic Restriction Sleaford Carnival Procession & Ray Butler Criterium Road Race. This item was noted.

A.8. NEW OR AMENDED APPLICATIONS FOR DISCUSSION.

- 8.1 **15/0569/RESM Land off Furlong Way and South of A17 Holdingham.**Persimmon Homes East Midlands. Revised matters application for the erection of 290 dwellings, public open space, highway works and associated infrastructure (details of access, appearance, landscaping, layout and scale pursuant to 12/1022/OUT) NOTE: Letter of concern from resident, received.
- The letter of concern from resident was noted; however some issues raised not permissible material objections and others are outside the remit of the Town Council.
- In discussion, concern was expressed relating to infrastructure needed to support this and other planned developments. In particular the management of traffic in/out of the north side of the town is not being given consideration. It was noted that the two applications under consideration (8.1 & 8.2) will effect a 5% increase in dwellings in the Town.
- O20 Cllr S Fields left the meeting at 7:46pm.
- 021 **IT WAS RESOLVED THAT** to comment on these concerns. Vote Unanimous. The Resolution was carried, NKDC to be notified accordingly.
- O22 Councillor J Charlesworth volunteered to be STC's representative speaker at KDC's Planning Committee meeting.

- 8.2 14/1257/OUT (amended) Land South of Grantham Road and West of Northfield Road. Larkfleet Homes. Erection of up to 200 dwellings with public open space and associated infrastructure including formation of roundabout to Grantham Road and new access onto Northfield Road (outline with means of access). Amendment: Revised application description amending scheme from 230 to 200 dwellings, revised drainage details and additional details of proposed roundabout.
- It was agreed to utilise the expertise of the Council's Planning Consultants and **IT WAS RESOLVED THAT** Cllr J Charlesworth would draft a reply, based on the Planning Consultants' advice and get approval from the Clerk. Vote Unanimous. The Resolution was carried.
- 8.3 **15/0623/LBC 19 Southgate, NG34 7SU.** Pygott & Crone. Replacement of fascia sign, installation of projecting sign, installation of sliding glass door and painting front of building.
- 026 **IT WAS RESOLVED** that there be no comments to this application. Vote Unanimous. The Resolution was carried, NKDC to be notified accordingly.
- 027 8.4 **15/0343/FUL Riverside Guest House, 47 West Banks.** A. Laidlan. Change of use from shop unit to bed and breakfast and retrospective permission for replacement shopfront.
- 028 **IT WAS RESOLVED** that there are no comments to this application. Vote 8 for and 4 abstentions. The Resolution was carried, NKDC to be notified accordingly.

- 8.5 14/1520/OUT (amended) Land to The Rear of Units 2-5 The Reservation, East Road. Pocklington Pemberton Farming Partnership. Outline application for Industrial Development (mixed use B1, B2 and sui generis) including new highways access over adjoining land. Amendment to travel plan and technical note for works to A153/A17 junction (provision of roundabout.)
- o31 **IT WAS RESOLVED** to make no comments to the amendment. Vote 7 for and 6 abstentions. The Resolution was carried, NKDC to be notified accordingly.
- 032 8.6 **15/0631/FUL Redcroft Day Nursery, 31A Mareham Lane.** Mr & Mrs Mewse. Erection of dwelling and associated works.
- O33 Comments regarding increased parking had been submitted to the office.
- 034 **IT WAS RESOLVED** to comment:
 - The proposed development will reduce parking provision for users of the Nursery and, therefore, increase parking on Mareham Lane itself (Highway Safety).
 - There are also (Agenda item 11) Proposed Traffic Regulation Orders in the vicinity of the New Life Centre which is in close proximity to Redcroft Day Nursery.

- It is likely that an increase in parking near Redcroft Day Nursery will give rise to a situation similar to that which already exists at New Life Centre. Vote – Unanimous. The Resolution was carried, NKDC to be notified accordingly.
- 8.7 **15/0771/HOUS 15 Barnes Close, NG34 8BF.** Erection of a single storey rear extension.
- 036 **IT WAS RESOLVED** that there are no comments to this application. Vote Unanimous. The Resolution was carried, NKDC to be notified accordingly.
- 8.8 **15/0725/HOUS 4 Bass Cottages, Mareham Lane, NG34 7JS.** Erection of a single storey extension.
