FC.1 APOLOGIES. Apologies, with reasons were given by Councillors T Mayfield, K Dolby, J Mathieson and D Birks. These were accepted.

FC.2 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST. To receive any interests. There were none.

FC.3 CHRISTMAS LIGHTS – To approve virements from Earmarked Reserves to cover costs of previously approved additional lighting in the Market Place.

The Services Supervisor explained which additional trees were being illuminated – agreed through the WG to the GP Committee.

Some points about the financial addition to the extra contract were explained. Cllr M Allan questioned various aspects and these were answered.

Details of the lights – colours and types – were also clarified.

Cllr B Watson said as Mayor, he had attended the opening of the new Restaurant in the former cinema.

Cllr K Fernandes said the Zygote organisers had thanked the Town Council.

Cllr D Vere-Critchler asked if this agenda item was only about the virement of funds – the Chairman agreed it was. Cllr M Allan asked for clarification – the Chairman explained.

Cllr D Suiter said that the lights would have to be scrutinised before the contract ends – a review to take place.

It was proposed by Cllr K Fernandes and seconded by Cllr H Lorimer that the virement from Earmarked Reserves to cover the costs of the approved additional lighting in the market place be approved.
